Part 詞類	Explanation 說明	Example 範例
Nouns 名詞	are names of people, places and qualities	man; desk; happiness Taipei; Christina
Verbs 動詞	describe actions, states or experience	go; study; drink; push; break; understand
Auxiliaries 助動詞	are used with main verbs to show the tense, mood etc.	do; will; can; may; must; should
Adjectives 形容詞	describe nouns	She' s a pretty woman. I' m sleepy .
Adverbs 副詞	describe verbs, Adj., Adv., or a sentence	He walks slowly . She runs very fast .
Prepositions 介係詞	are used before nouns to show time, place, direction etc.	in the box; on the table; at 7:00; go to school
Conjunctions 連接詞	connect parts of sentences, phrases, or clauses.	and; but; because Though I' m poor, I am happy.
Interjections 感嘆詞	are used to express surprise, shock, pain etc.	Ouch! It hurts! Hurray! We won.
Articles 冠詞	help us to refer to nouns	You can see a girl at the door. The girl is my best friend.
